Santiago Ramon-Garcia is currently WP2 (*in vitro* profiling) coordinator of the ERA4TB consortium (<https://era4tb.org/>) and coordinator of a multi-country clinical trial in West Africa to develop a novel therapy for Buruli ulcer. He leads and collaborates in several other antimicrobial development projects focusing on Gram-negative and non-tuberculosis mycobacterial infections, with special focus on cystic fibrosis.

Santiago has worked both in academia and in industry where he has acquired a thorough knowledge of antimicrobial resistance and the process of discovery of antimicrobial drugs, from basic science to translational research.
